Students completing the Graphic Arts/Desktop Publishing program at Illinois Central College and receiving their Associate in Applied Science Degree are eligible to enroll in the Graphic Design Program at Robert Morris College to complete their Bachelor of Applied Science in Graphic Design Degree. Students will make a smooth transition with all credits from the Associate of Applied Science Degree being accepted in their entirety.
